



Eagle County Airport (EGE)

Eagle County Airport (EGE) is located 70 miles (113 km) from Aspen/Snowmass. Served by five airlines with nonstop flights from 12 cities during the winter, and one-stop connections from cities throughout the world. Air service subject to change.



Aircraft: 757 jet service, 188 seats

Nonstop service to Eagle:

- Dallas/Ft. Worth, TX (2-4 flights daily)
- Chicago/O'Hare, IL (1-2 flights daily)
- Los Angeles, CA (1 flight daily)
- New York/La Guardia, NY (Saturday)
- New York/JFK, NY (1 flight daily)
- Miami, FL (5 flights per week)



Aircraft: 737-700 jet service, 138 seats

Nonstop service to Eagle:

- George Bush International Airport, Houston, TX (1 flight daily)
- Newark International, NJ (1 flight daily)



Aircraft: 757 jet service, 183 seats

Nonstop service to Eagle: Atlanta, GA (1 flight daily)



Aircraft: Airbus A-320, 138 seats / CRJ-700, 66 seats operated by Sky West

Nonstop service to Eagle: Denver, CO (3 flights daily)

ADDITIONAL AIRPORTS

Denver International Airport (DEN): Located 220 miles (354 km) from Aspen and Snowmass Village. Over 400 daily flights are offered into Denver from over 80 cities on 18 airlines, including international nonstops from London/Heathrow (British Airways) and Frankfurt (Lufthansa).

Grand Junction Regional Airport (GJT): Located 130 miles (209 km) from Aspen and Snowmass Village. Frequent connecting flights from various US cities and nonstop flights from Las Vegas and Los Angeles.
